

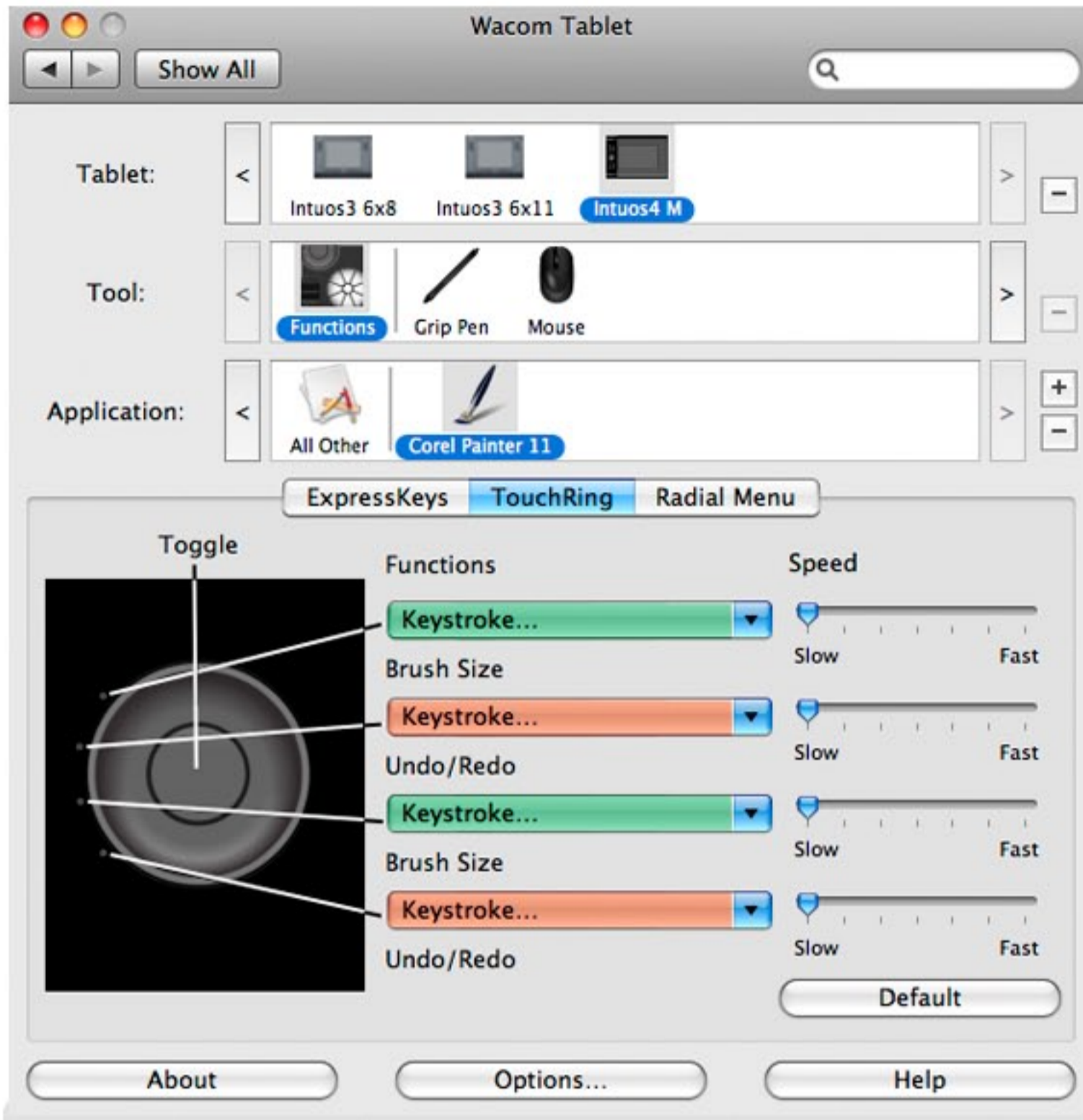
Mapping the Wacom Intuos4 TouchRing & ExpressKeys to Control Corel Painter Functions



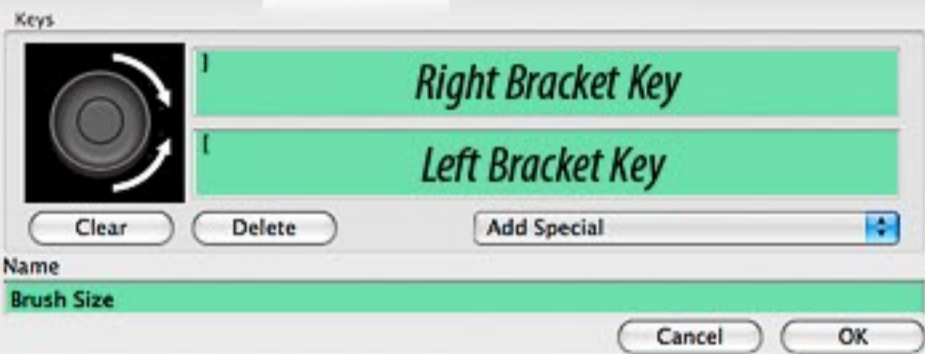
The settings and functions shown reflect what I've found to be useful. You may want to experiment and map settings that fit your workflow.

You'll notice that I've doubled the Brush Size and Undo/Redo functions on the TouchRing. Because I use these so often, I did this so that either function is only one click away.

I use the TouchRing for subtle brush size adjustment, and the bottom ExpressKey for quick large-scale brush size adjustments.

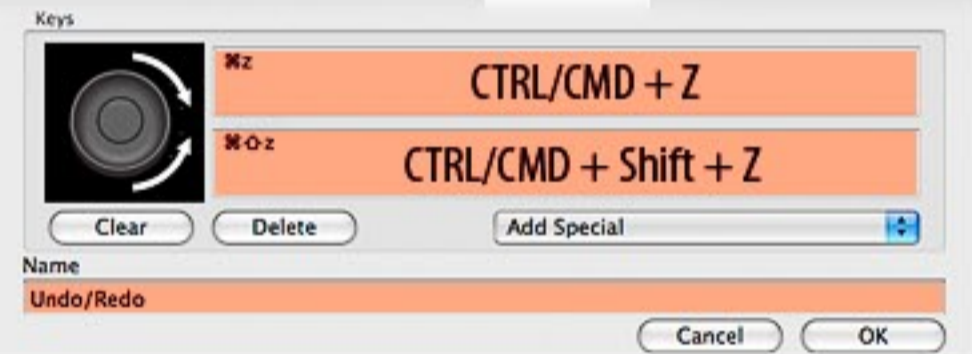


Brush Size



With the TouchRing function set to Keystroke..., apply the keyboard command shown.

Undo/Redo



With the ExpressKeys function set to Keystroke..., apply the keyboard commands listed below.

CTRL/CMD + - (minus)

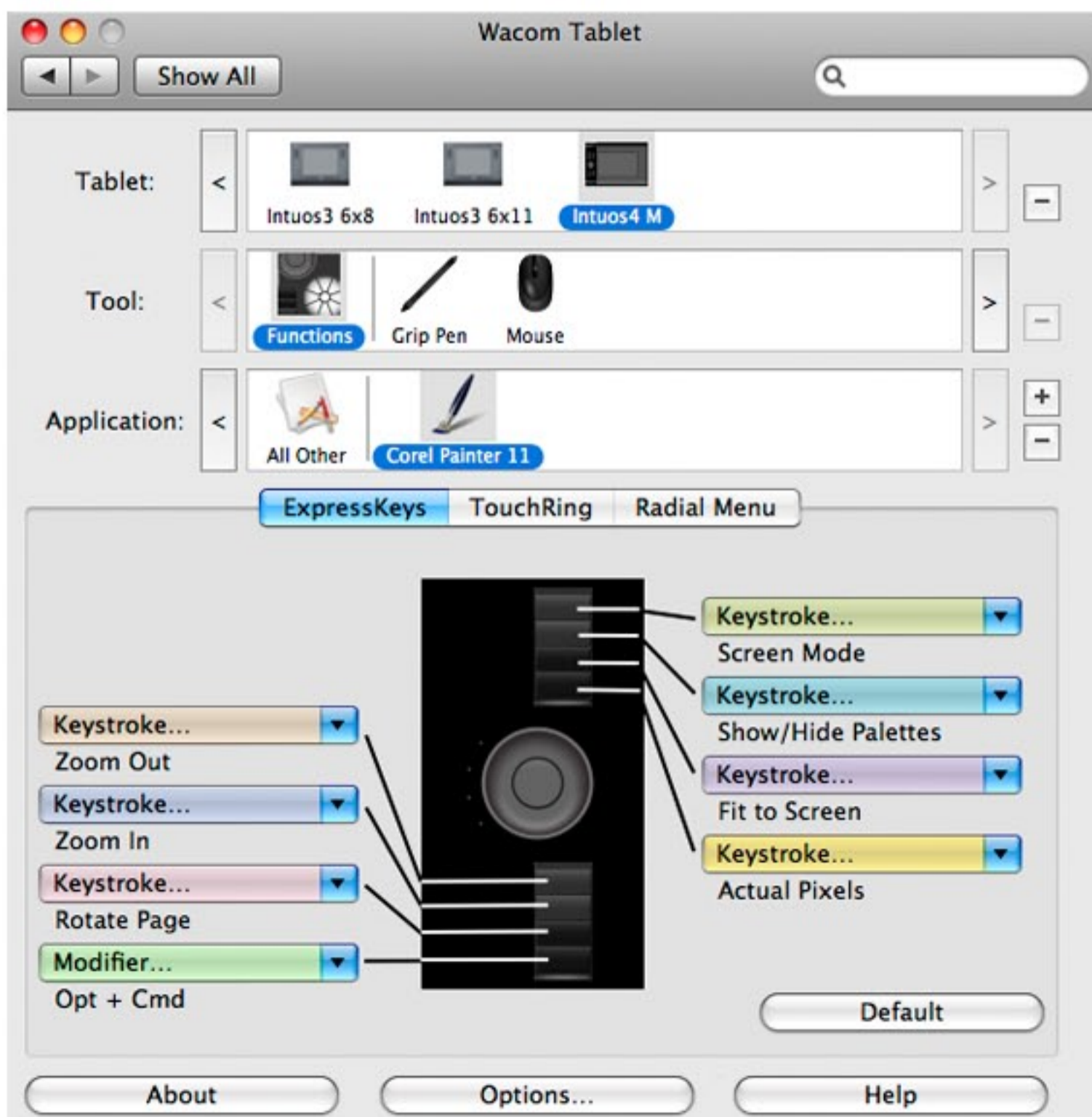
CTRL/CMD + = (equal)

ALT/OPT + Spacebar

With the ExpressKeys function set to Modifier..., apply the keyboard commands listed below.

ALT/OPT + CTRL/CMD

Use the ALT/OPT + CTRL/CMD command to click-and-drag on an image and quickly make large-scale brush size changes.



My tablet is set up for a left-handed user; if you are right-handed, your ExpressKeys layout may look different.

With the ExpressKeys function set to Keystroke..., apply the keyboard commands listed below.

CTRL/CMD + M

Tab Key

CTRL/CMD + 0

CTRL/CMD + ALT/OPT + 0

CTRL: Windows CONTROL key
ALT: Windows ALTERNATE key
CMD: Mac COMMAND (⌘) key
OPT: Mac OPTION key
